HOMEOPATHY AT A GLANCE: COLOMBIA

COLOMBIA HOSTED THE LMHI INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF HOMEOPATHY IN 2023. COLOMBIA PROVES TO BE A COUNTRY WITH A PROMISING FUTURE FOR HOMEOPATHY.

READ BELOW WHAT OUR NVP TELLS US ABOUT IT:

Homeopathy made its way to Colombia from Europe in 1885, and since then, various educational institutions have played a role in its development. However, its official recognition as a legitimate medical practice came with the enactment of Law 35 in 1992.

Currently, Colombia boasts two accredited entities for the specialization in Human Homeopathy and Veterinary Homeopathy at UNIPAEZ University. Moreover, the National University of Colombia offers a Master's program in Homeopathy. These programs adhere to credit standards set by the Ministry of National Education and are endorsed by the Ministry of Health for medical or veterinary specialization and for the master's degree respectively. These institutions have forged agreements with three public hospitals in Bogota for clinical practices.

A total of 193 doctors have graduated as specialists in Human Homeopathy in Colombia, including 11 from Ecuador and 2 from Venezuela. Additionally, 118 doctors hold a Master's degree in Homeopathy, and 42 veterinarians have specialized in homeopathy. These professionals are dispersed across more than 15 cities nationwide.

In addition to formal education, six other universities offer non-formal education programs, featuring short courses in complex homeopathy, pluralistic homeopathy, and homotoxicology. Sponsored by pharmaceutical companies or organized informally by individuals, these courses have trained around 4500 health professionals. The duration varies from 3 to 6 months, with training intensities ranging from 100 to 120 hours of Homeopathic information. Furthermore, an Alternative Medicine and Plant Pharmacology program, including 100 hours of education in homeopathy, contributes to the educational landscape.

The credibility of these programs in Colombia has prompted some health service providers to incorporate Alternative Medicine, including Homeopathy, into their premium or VIP service offerings. Notably, high-complexity hospital centers, both in the public and private sectors, allow outpatient homeopathic consultations for their users.

INVITATION FOR LMHI CONGRESS 2024

Dear professionals, patients, users and friends of homeopathy:

Commemorating the centenary of the proposal for the creation of the LMHI at the International Congress of Homeopathy held in 1924 in Barcelona (Spain), the National Assembly of Homeopathy (ANH) has made the commitment to organize the LMHI congress for 2024.

The city chosen as the venue, Seville, has among other merits, being the birthplace of Dr.

Prudencio Querol, pioneer of Spanish Homeopathy with its successful homeopathic treatments for chronically ill patients carried out in the hospital San Sebastian de Badajoz during the years 1832-1838 and during the cholera epidemic suffered in the city of Extremadura.

Under the slogan "United to continue advancing", we are organizing a congress that covers the various aspects of Homeopathy: research and science, regulation and rights, teaching and professionalization, clinical, theoretical bases and historical development, professional

development: doctors, pharmacists, veterinarians, dentists. Other aspects related to homeopathy that will also be addressed at the congress will be agrohomeopathy and its contribution to public health by improving plant and animal production in achieving healthier food, reducing global pollution and improving global health within the ONE HEALTH concept.

Throughout the congress there will be an inaugural conference, round tables, papers, communications, posters, workshops, a stand of registered authors' books and a closing conference. Also, parallel activities will be developed by patient associations that will have an important space for participation. In addition to all this, the general public will be able to

enjoy the Informative Exhibition on Homeopathy in the World. The development of the congress in the facilities of the Barceló-Discovery hotel in Isla Magica, and its surroundings will be the meeting point, where we will be able to enjoy four days of professional, cultural, gastronomic and recreational-festive coexistence. From here, we invite all interested people to participate in this congress that will mark a before and after in the proper perception of Homeopathy in Spain as a showcase of World Homeopathy. We are waiting for you in Seville, united to continue advancing.
